GOOGLE APPS @ UCONN

HUSKY ONE CARD (University ID)

The Husky One Card is used to gain access to University Library services. In addition, the Husky One Card has been setup with a HUSKY Bucks account (a debit account-like program) which can be used to purchase goods and services at various locations on and off campus. Once funds are deposited into the HUSKY Bucks account, the student simply uses the Husky One Card for purchases at approved, participating locations including: *Coop Bookstore, College printing & copying services*
